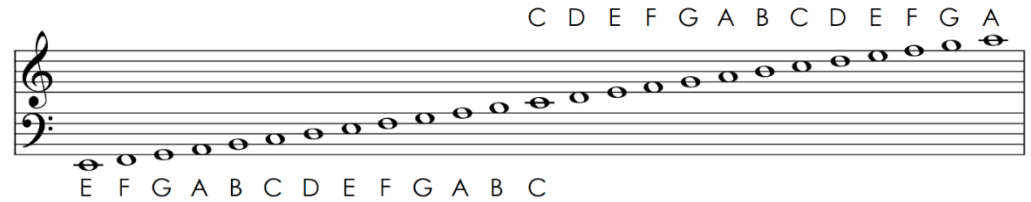
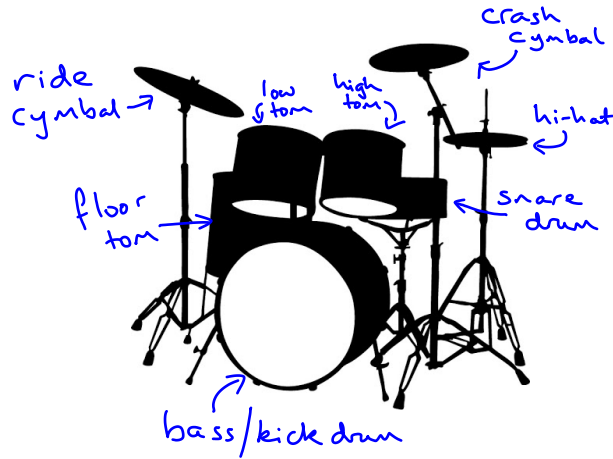

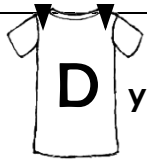

		semiquaver	1/4 of a beat



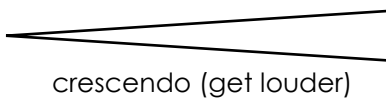
