

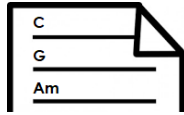

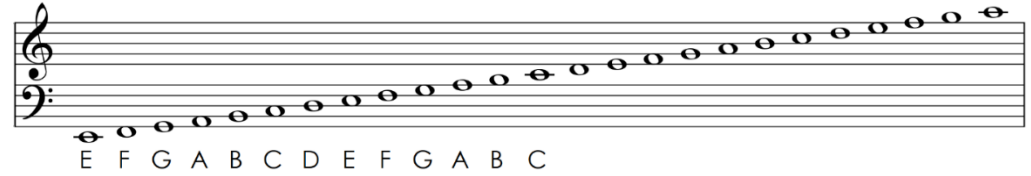

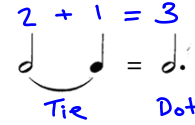
## Guitars

**Instrumental**

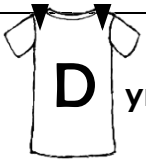
A section which doesn't contain any singing
