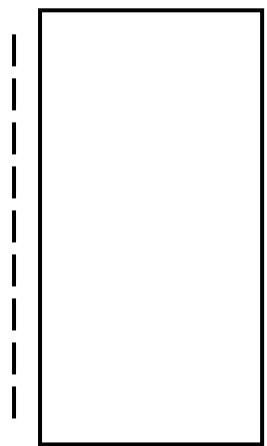
USE OF VOICE

Tone: soft/harsh



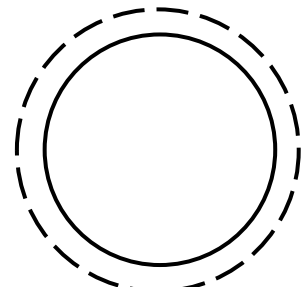

IN THE ROUND

Dramatic Technique	Definition
narration	When one character tells the story to the audience.
mime	Performing without speaking.
cross-cut	Two simultaneous scenes are shown alternately, sharing the same stage.
freeze frame	A still image.
monologue	A speech given by one character to the audience.
flashback	A scene that takes place in the past.
mark the moment	Drawing attention to an important event in the piece.
chorus	A collective narration.
physical theatre	A collection of bodies to represent a unified idea.
